

<b>UA92 “Make it for Real” Package (Terms and Conditions)</b>	
<b>What is the value?</b>	Each package for degree students is worth a minimum of £5,000 and will be paid over three years of study. For Cert HE students it is worth a minimum of £1666.66 for one year of study.
<b>What does the “Make it For Real” package contain?</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Free Lunch.</b> A payment card for lunches from the Co-op worth at least £3.50 each weekday from the first day of study to the final day of teaching on their course.</li> <li>2. <b>Free Laptop/Microsoft Surface device.</b> A laptop/surface device issued to students following completion of registration at UA92.</li> <li>3. <b>Free Unlimited Wi-Fi.</b> This will either be included as part of the students contract with Manchester Apartments (Westpoint or Academy Apartments) or via a wired or wireless connection supplied by Talk Talk.</li> <li>4. <b>Free Travel.</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) For students whose address upon application is in Greater Manchester this is a Travel Card covering travel from their home address to UA92 during term time.</li> <li>(b) For students whose address upon application is outside Greater Manchester this will be a £200 payment issued in each year of study, to help fund travel between their home and student accommodation at UA92.</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. <b>Free Home Starter Kit.</b> Paid in the form of a £150 payment/home voucher.</li> <li>6. <b>Cash top-up.</b> For any students whose package does not total £5000 or more (from receiving 1-5 above) they will receive a cash payment in their final year of study.</li> </ol>
<b>How and when will “Make it for Real” recipients get each element of the package?</b>	<p>Subject to completing student registration at UA92 and having student finance in place, those awarded the package will receive each element as follows;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Free Lunch.</b> Students will receive this during their first week of induction at UA92. Or not later than 5 working days after successful registration.</li> <li>2. <b>Free Laptop/Microsoft Surface Device.</b> Students will receive this during their first week of induction eh at UA92. Or not later than 5 working days after successful registration.</li> <li>3. <b>Free Unlimited Wi-Fi.</b> If living at Westpoint or Academy Apartments from the point the student moves in. If through Talk Talk not later than six weeks after successful registration.</li> <li>4. <b>Free Travel</b> (a) - Students will receive this during their first week of induction at UA92. Or not later than 5 working days after successful registration. (b) – Students will receive this payment approximately one week before enrolment. Or not later than 5 working days after successful registration.</li> </ol>

	<p>5. <b>Free Home Starter Kit.</b> Students will receive this as soon as they have successfully enrolled, and their student finance payment has been triggered.</p> <p>6. <b>Cash top-up.</b> Any payment that students are entitled to due to the package not being worth at least £5000 (or £1666.66 for Cert HE students) will be paid during their final block of their final year of study.</p>
<p><b>What are the eligibility criteria?</b></p>	<p>To obtain a “Make it for Real” support grant applicants must be 20 years or under at the date they begin studying at UA92, and have been in receipt of free school meals <a href="https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals">https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals</a> in their most recent year of school or college.</p> <p>To demonstrate this, students will need to provide UA92 with proof of being in receipt of the free school meals themselves or evidence of their parents/guardians being in receipt of one of the following benefits at the point of application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Income Support</li> <li>• Income-based Jobseeker’s Allowance</li> <li>• Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)</li> <li>• Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999</li> <li>• The guaranteed element of Pension Credit</li> <li>• Child Tax Credit (provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty’s Revenue and Customs (HMRC))</li> <li>• Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after someone stops qualifying for Working Tax Credit</li> <li>• Universal Credit with net earnings not exceeding the equivalent of £7,400 pa (after tax and not including any benefits received)</li> </ul>
<p><b>What are the ongoing conditions of the package?</b></p>	<p>To receive the package, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete registration/re-registration with UA92 (via Lancaster University). Note: Students must register on their course by the given start date. Packages cannot be deferred to the following academic year.</li> <li>• Have satisfactory attendance (as defined by the <a href="https://ua92.ac.uk/storage/app/media/ua92-attendance-and-engagement-policy-1.pdf">https://ua92.ac.uk/storage/app/media/ua92-attendance-and-engagement-policy-1.pdf</a>)</li> <li>• Have confirmed financial support for tuition fees in place and UA92 must be receiving those tuition fees in line with agreed payment schedules.</li> <li>• Not have withdrawn or interrupted their studies at UA92.</li> </ul> <p>All payments are subject to successful progression from year to year, as confirmed by the UA92 Board of Examiners.</p>

<p><b>What are the conditions?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicable only to “Home” students in receipt of student finance via Student Finance England/Wales/Northern Ireland.</li> <li>• Students can only be awarded one grant, and this cannot be combined with any other UA92 scholarship, grant or bursary award.</li> <li>• Students cannot be studying for an accelerated degree.</li> <li>• The above eligibility criteria may be subject to change at any time by UA92.</li> <li>• UA92 reserves the right to cap the number of “Make it for Real” packages awarded at any time and in any year with all packages operating on a first come first serve basis.</li> <li>• Recipients agree to UA92 using their name and image in its publicity, marketing and recruitment materials, and on its website, including arranging for the student to have their portrait taken by a photographer for UA92.</li> <li>• Recipients agree to UA92 contacting them approximately two years after graduation for an update on how the package has influenced their career.</li> <li>• Where UA92 believe a recipient has made a false or fraudulent application, payments of this award will be stopped pending investigation.</li> <li>• Where any investigation concludes fraudulent activity has taken place, UA92 reserves the right to void the package and reclaim the full value of the package.</li> </ul>
<p><b>How do I apply?</b></p>	<p>Once interested parties have applied to study at UA92 they will be sent a survey asking for further information. We will then be in touch if we require further information or evidence to confirm eligibility.</p>
<p><b>What happens if my make it for real items get lost or stolen or breakdown?</b></p>	<p>UA92 accepts no liability for the damage, loss or theft of the laptop or any other part of the package detailed above. UA92 would recommend that all students insure the laptop/surface and other valuable assets.</p>
