

	UA92 Disability Transition Support Grant (Terms and Conditions) - From September 2026 Entry onwards.
What is the value?	<p>Each grant for CertHE/degree students is valued at £200.00 and will be issued in payment at the start of study.</p> <p>The grant can be used to help towards the cost of your transition to UA92 or can be put towards a contribution towards the cost of a computer or laptop if you have been approved for DSA support.</p>
How and when will recipients receive the Declared Disability Support Grant?	<p>Subject to completing student registration at UA92 and having student finance in place, those awarded the package will be issued a payment valued at £200.00 through the Aspire Scheme by no later than the second week of teaching.</p>
What are the eligibility criteria?	<p>1. Students must have declared they have a disability in their UCAS or direct application to UA92.</p> <p>And</p> <p>2. Live in an IMD2019 Quintile 1 (Decile 1 or 2) postcode at the point of application.</p> <p>IMD2019 Deciles can be checked here.</p> <p>Please note that we are unable to assess applicants living outside of the UK or those from the Channel Islands or Isle of Man.</p> <p>And</p> <p>3. Enrol on a Cert HE, Degree or Accelerated course at UA92 from September 2026 onwards.</p> <p>Eligibility for this bursary will be assessed based on the postcode submitted on your UCAS application. If your residential address changes after submitting your application, you may be required to provide valid proof of address to confirm continued eligibility.</p>
What are the conditions?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students must register on their chosen programme at the start date they applied for. Grants cannot be deferred to the following academic year, or alternative start points unless explicitly agreed by UA92 in writing. • Have confirmed financial support for tuition fees in place and UA92 must be receiving those tuition fees in line with agreed payment schedules. • Applicable only to “Home” students in receipt of student finance via Student Finance England/Wales/Northern Ireland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The above eligibility criteria may be subject to change at any time by UA92.• Where UA92 believe a recipient has made a false or fraudulent application, payments of this award will be stopped pending investigation.• Where any investigation concludes fraudulent activity has taken place, UA92 reserves the right to void the Grant and reclaim the full amount of award payments made.• This grant can be combined with any other grant awarded by UA92 as detailed in our 2026 to 2030 Access and Participation Plan.
