

UA92 Go for It Bursary Terms & Conditions (from September 2026)

What is the value?	Each grant is worth a total £3000 for accelerated students across two years at UA92.
How and when will recipients get the scholarship?	<p>Subject to completing student registration at UA92 and having student finance confirmed and in place, the £3000 will be paid across the three levels of study.</p> <p>Level 4 –£500 by no later than week three of block two and no later than week three of block four. Level 5 - £500 by no later than week three of block six and no later than week three of block two. Level 6 - £500 by no later than week three of block four and no later than week three of block six.</p> <p>The money will be paid directly via the UA92 Aspire portal.</p>
What are the eligibility criteria?	<p>To obtain a UA92 accelerated bursary, you must</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be registered to study on an Accelerated degree programme at UA92 2. Live in a IMD2019 Quintile 1 (Deciles 1 and 2) postcode area at point of application. This can be checked using https://imd-by-postcode.opendatacommunities.org/imd/2019 <p>Eligibility for this bursary will be assessed based on the postcode submitted on your UCAS application. If your residential address changes after submitting your application, you may be required to provide valid proof of address to confirm continued eligibility.</p>
What are the conditions of the scholarship?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicable only to “Home” students in receipt of student finance via Student Finance England/Wales/Northern Ireland. • This grant can only be combined with other financial support packages at UA92 (e.g. Make it For Real) in exceptional circumstances and with the expressed permission of UA92 • The above eligibility criteria may be subject to change at any time by UA92. • Recipients agree to UA92 using their name and image in its publicity, marketing and recruitment materials, and on its website, including arranging for the student to have their portrait taken by a photographer for UA92. • Recipients agree to UA92 contacting them approximately two years after graduation for an update on how the scholarship has influenced their career.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where UA92 believe a recipient has made a false or fraudulent application, the scholarship will be stopped pending investigation. • Where any investigation concludes fraudulent activity has taken place, UA92 reserves the right to void the scholarship and reclaim the full value of it.
<p>What are the ongoing conditions of the scholarship?</p>	<p>To receive the scholarship, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete registration/re-registration with UA92 (via Lancaster University). Note: Students must register on their course by the given start date. Scholarships cannot be deferred to the following academic year or entry point. • Have satisfactory attendance of 75% or above • Have confirmed financial support for tuition fees in place • Not have withdrawn their studies at UA92 (due to own choice or academic failure). The scholarship is subject to successful progression from year to year, as confirmed by the UA92 Board of Examiners. • Not have changed from the one-year CertHE programme or the three-year degree programme.
