

UA92 Make it for Real Bursary Package (Terms and Conditions) – With effect from September 2026 Entry	
What is the value?	Each package for degree students is worth a minimum of £5,000.00 and will be paid over three years of study. For Accelerated students it is worth £5,000.00 and will be paid over two years of study. For Cert HE students it is worth a minimum of £1666.66 for one year of study.
What does the “Make it For Real” package contain?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Free Lunch. Food vouchers from Tesco, Sainsbury’s or Aldi to spend on lunch worth at least £4.00 each weekday from the first day of study to the final day of teaching on their course per academic year. 2. Free Laptop A laptop issued to students. 3. Free Travel A payment of £170.00 per six-week block covering travel from their address to UA92 during term time. 4. Free Home Starter Kit. Paid in the form of a £150.00 payment/home voucher. 5. Cash top-up. For any students whose package does not total £5,000.00 or more (from receiving 1-5 above) they will receive a cash payment in their final year of study.
How and when will “Make it for Real” recipients get each element of the package?	<p>Subject to completing student registration at UA92 and having student finance in place, those awarded the package will receive each element as follows;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Free Lunch. Students will receive this after completing registration at UA92, typically no later than the second week of teaching. 2. Free Laptop. Students will receive this after completing registration at UA92, typically no later than the second week of teaching. 3. Free Travel Students will receive this after completing registration at UA92, typically no later than the second week of teaching. 4. Free Home Starter Kit. Students will receive this after completing registration at UA92, typically and no later than the second week of teaching. 5. Cash top-up. Any payment that students are entitled to due to the package not being worth at least £5,000.00 (or £1666.66 for Cert HE students) will be paid during their final block of their final year of study.
What are the eligibility criteria?	<p>To obtain a “Make it for Real” support grant applicants must be 20 years or under at the date they begin studying at UA92, and either have been in receipt of free school meals https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals in their most recent year of school or college or recognised as Care experienced https://www.support-for-care-leavers.education.gov.uk/en/who-care-leaver-support-is-for#definition-in-care-or-looked-after</p> <p>To demonstrate this, students will need to provide UA92 with proof; of being in receipt of the free school meals themselves. This will be in the format of a letter from local authority or educational institution stating students name and confirming they received free school meals.</p>

	<p>Or</p> <p>of being care experienced. This will be in the format of a letter from your local authority confirming you were 'looked after' and when, often from your social worker or leaving care team.</p> <p>All applications are assessed by the Student Success team and their decision is final.</p>
<p>What are the ongoing conditions of the package?</p>	<p>To receive the package, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete registration/re-registration with UA92 (via Lancaster University). Note: Students must register on their course by the given start date. Packages cannot be deferred to the following academic year. • Have satisfactory attendance of 75% or above • Have confirmed financial support for tuition fees in place and UA92 must be receiving those tuition fees in line with agreed payment schedules. • Not have withdrawn or interrupted their studies at UA92. <p>All payments are subject to successful progression from year to year, as confirmed by the UA92 Board of Examiners.</p>
<p>What are the conditions?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicable only to “Home” students in receipt of student finance via Student Finance England/Wales/Northern Ireland. • This grant can only be combined with other financial support packages at UA92 (e.g. Go for It) in exceptional circumstances and with the expressed permission of UA92 • The above eligibility criteria may be subject to change at any time by UA92. • If you defer your start date to a later entry month or year the bursary may no longer be payable. • UA92 reserves the right to cap the number of “Make it for Real” packages awarded at any time and in any year with all packages operating on a first come first serve basis. • Recipients agree to UA92 using their name and image in its publicity, marketing and recruitment materials, and on its website, including arranging for the student to have their portrait taken by a photographer for UA92. • Recipients agree to UA92 contacting them approximately two years after graduation for an update on how the package has influenced their career. • Where UA92 believe a recipient has made a false or fraudulent application, payments of this award will be stopped pending investigation. • Where any investigation concludes fraudulent activity has taken place, UA92 reserves the right to void the package and reclaim the full value of the package.

How do I apply?	Once interested parties have applied to study at UA92 they will be sent a survey asking for further information. We will then be in touch if we require further information or evidence to confirm eligibility.
What happens if my make it for real items get lost or stolen or breakdown?	UA92 accepts no liability for the damage, loss or theft of the laptop or any other part of the package detailed above. UA92 would recommend that all students insure the laptop/surface and other valuable assets.
